Course Description: Two semesters in length: Fall, 2011 and Spring, 2012. This course will cover all concepts listed in the table of contents of Math 8Z, copyright 1991, by Saxon Publishers, Inc.

Course Goals: The main goal of this class is to establish a solid foundation in the study of math in preparation of higher math courses such as Algebra I and Geometry and as needed for other life skills.

Required Materials: Standard classroom supplies: paper, pencils, positive “can do” attitude.

Learner Actions: Learner will

- achieve mastery of all skills presented (80% or better on assessments)
- attend all classroom sessions.
- be actively involved in the daily classroom instruction.
- complete every lesson as assigned.
- check and correct assignments in order to receive full credit.
- take assessments during Thursday lab unless other arrangements made prior to test.
- correct and retake any test which scores less than a 70%.

Course Assessments: Letter grade will be given based on 20% completed and corrected homework, 80% test scores. A=90-100%, B=80-89%, C=70-79%, F=69% or less.

Fee: \$250.00 per semester for an enrollment of 1-4 learners, \$200.00 per semester for 5 or more learners. Students will be billed for the first semester on September 26, 2011. Spring semester will be billed on January 23, 2012 .
